# Success Stories Sought for 2008 National Training Awards

The 2008 National Training Awards are seeking stories of how training has transformed businesses, organisations and communities in the Humber region.

For the past 22 years these annual Awards have celebrated organisations and individuals that demonstrate outstanding business and personal success through investment in training. They are run by UK Skills on behalf of the Department for Innovation, Universities and Skills and supported by the Learning and Skills Council in the Yorkshire and Humber region.

UK Skills Chief Executive Simon Bartley said: "We are looking for stories from individuals and organisations whose investment in training

has had big results. This could be through improving a business's productivity, reducing costs, boosting staff morale, or transforming a person's career."

He said changes had been made to this year's Awards to meet the needs of a 21st century economy and society. "We've introduced six new categories of awards which will recognise individuals, small to large employers, collaborations and partnerships, and organisations providing education and training. We've also streamlined the entry process and are accepting applications online.

The closing date for this year's Awards is Friday 25 April 2008. Free information sessions about the Awards and how to

enter are being held in York on 18 March and 3 April, Hull on 20 March and Scunthorpe on 2 April.

## BME (Black & Minority Ethnic) Success

HLC's BME Partnership Project came to an end in December. Its main achievement has been to engage with and support the development of BME organisations to provide learning programmes to people from their communities, delivered in the community. Over 500 learners have been supported throughout the Humber region, of these over 300 have gone into further education or training and over 70 into employment. HLC worked with 10 organisations, 8 of which are BME, to achieve this. Volunteer learning mentors were trained to level two and are now working within their own BME communities.

For the final part of the project three organisations were supported to introduce a full quality framework which will enable them to work towards being able to access mainstream funding in the future if they so wish. The success of the project is due to the flexibility of the organisations in welcoming learners from all backgrounds, ethnicity and race, particularly true when economic migrants started joining the groups. It is also due to the effectiveness of their informal networks, in engaging often marginalised learners, in activities to improve their isolated status and employability.

## Teachers; Are You Ready For This?

If you deliver learning as a trainer or teacher you will be included in the governments 'Further Education Workforce Reforms'

From September 2007 the government expects that all new staff employed as teachers, tutors, trainers, lectures and instructors in the FE sector must be professionally registered and licensed to practice by the institute for leadership (IFL).

New qualifications have been introduced based on new professional standards. All teachers must also undertake professional development activity which is formally recorded to maintain professional status.

Staff who began teaching prior to 2001 are eligible for exemptions.
